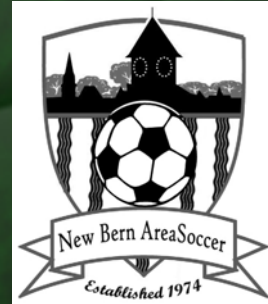

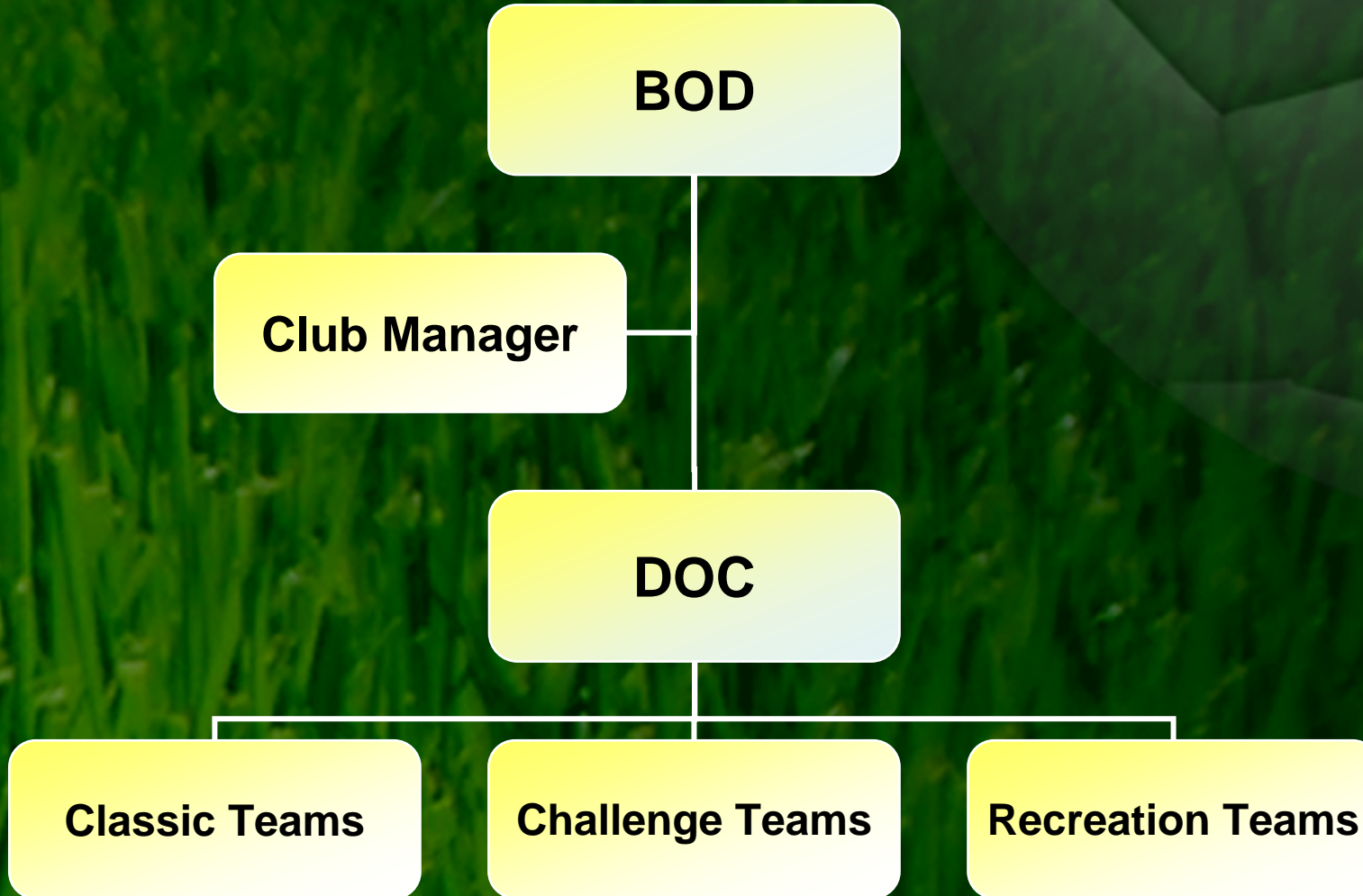
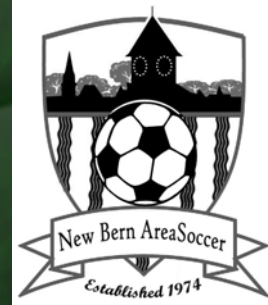

NBASA Structure

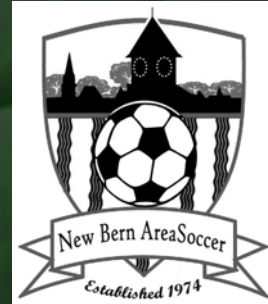

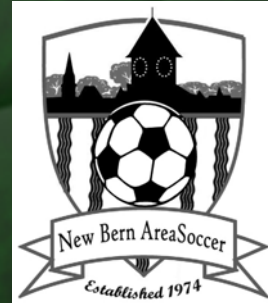

Boys Classic Teams

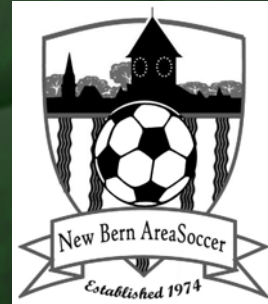


Program Operations

Director of Coaching Responsibilities

- Responsible for overseeing or conducting all player and coaches training
- Selects all game coaches and paid classic coaches
 - Classic teams may have a team representative included in the selection process
- Scheduling and prioritizing fields/practices
- Team Communication
- Continuing Education Classes for Rec Coaches
- Conducts weekly training session for all Recreation players in age applicable groups.
(example: U5/6/8/10 every other week)



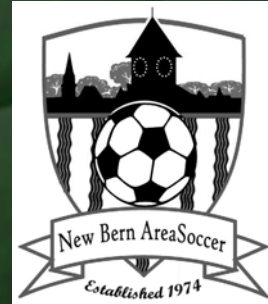


Classic Program

Learning

DOC ensures:

- U11 – U18 Boys & Girls – one team per age group unless there is a solid second team
- Player Movement
- Players can be moved from Challenge to Classic or Classic to Challenge at anytime based on player development
- Roster Size – 12 players for U11/12
- Roster Size – 16 players for U13/16
- Roster Size – 18 players for U17/18



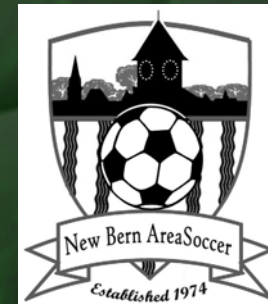


Challenge Program

Coaches

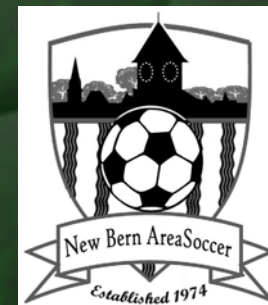
- Challenge should be limited to U10 – U12
- All Age Groups will be trained by the DOC
- U9 Youth Development Players (YDP)
- Game day coaches will be an assistant coaches/parent coaches
- Minimum of “D” License or equivalent (“E” for U10 only)

Player Movement

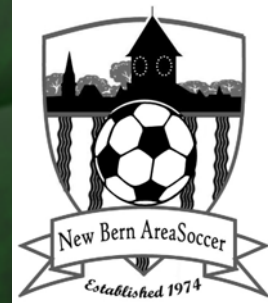
- **Players can be moved from Challenge to Classic at anytime based on player development**

- **Recommended Roster Size**
 - **U10 – 10 Players**
 - **U12 – 12 Players**
 - **U13 & up – 16 Players- Challenge teams at this age shall be avoided with a drive to Classic.**



Recreation Teams

Learning



- Unlimited number of teams per age group

- Create smaller roster sizes for all teams

- More touches – More Fun

- More touches – More Player Development

- More touches – More Parent Involvement

- Director of Coaching (DOC) Identify players for the next level

- Stronger emphasis on and more frequent player clinics

- Additional continuing education classes for coaches

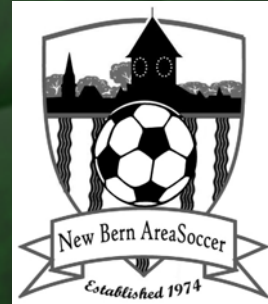

- **Employ the use of High School age paid Coaches with a committed team parent!!**
